The 2022 conference of the Luxembourg Educational Research Association (LuxERA) invites all people active and interested in educational research in and on Luxembourg to join the dialogue and provide their perspective on education (research). The conference provides an open space for a wide range of disciplinary, theoretical, methodological, and thematic contributions about education in Luxembourg and beyond, and aims to stimulate exchange and cooperation within the field of education and related fields, such as inclusive education, multilingualism, lifelong learning, history of education, and sociology of education, among others. Key themes include education systems; diversity and inclusion; multilingualism from early childhood to tertiary education; educational and social inequalities; assessment and diagnostics; teacher professionalisation; (digital) teaching and learning; (lifelong) cognitive adaptation and learning strategies. The conference will include a joint keynote and lunch with the College of Interdisciplinary Educational Research (CIDER), a leading network of postdoctoral and senior researchers.

Contributions: We invite educational researchers to contribute to the conference with a **paper presentation** of 20 minutes (plus 10 minutes of discussion) or a **poster**, to be presented and discussed in an interactive, moderated session.

Languages: English is the preferred language; we also welcome presentations in German, French, or Luxembourgish.

Abstracts (up to 300 words, excluding references) in the language of the presentation: The outline of your paper should cover key questions, theoretical issues, methodology, and (preliminary) findings. Please provide the following information: name, affiliation, e-mail address, and indicate if you are an early-career researcher (up to 5 years after PhD).

Participation: Participation will be free to all LuxERA members and €30 for non-members. We encourage all researchers in our community to join the association and to benefit from a discounted/free participation at ECER and LuxERA events. Deadline: The deadline for abstract submission is **1 July 2022**. You will be informed of the peer review outcome by end of August 2022. Please submit your abstract to <u>luxeraconf@uni.lu</u>.
