Call for Papers

The 2020 conference of the Luxembourg Educational Research Association (LuxERA) invites all people active and interested in educational research in and on Luxembourg to join the dialogue and provide their perspective on education (research). The conference provides an open space for a wide range of disciplinary, theoretical, methodological, and thematic contributions about inequalities in education systems in Luxembourg and beyond. Inequalities may be related to access to a wide range of (in)formal educational settings as well as the uptake of learning opportunities. Contributions could also address the ways in which these inequalities are (re)produced and experienced. The conference will include joined sessions with the College of Interdisciplinary Educational Research (CIDER), a leading network of postdoctoral and senior researchers. We encourage diverse participation, including emerging researchers, to present their projects. Key themes related to educational and social inequalities to be debated include education systems; diversity and inclusion; multilingualism from early childhood to tertiary education; educational and social inequalities; assessment and diagnostics; teacher professionalisation; (digital) teaching and learning; (lifelong) cognitive adaptation and learning strategies.

Contributions: We invite educational researchers to contribute to the conference with a presentation of 20 minutes (plus 10 minutes of discussion) or a poster, to be presented and discussed in an interactive, moderated session. Submitted papers should have an explicit focus on the conference theme. **Languages:** As this conference is linked to the CIDER meeting, English is the preferred language, although we would also welcome presentations in German, French, Luxembourgish (sign language interpreter available upon request). **Abstracts (300 words, excluding references) in the presentation language:** The outline of your paper should cover key questions, theoretical issues, methodology, and (preliminary) findings. Please provide the following information: Name, Affiliation, and E-mail address.

Deadline for abstract submission is 15 June 2020. You are informed after the peer review outcome by 15 July 2020. Please submit your abstract to luxeraconf@uni.lu.
