Call for Papers

The 2024 **LuxERA Conference** invites researchers to present their work to connect and exchange ideas on inclusion and inclusive teaching and learning in a collegial and friendly atmosphere on Belval campus.

The conference provides an open space for a **wide range** of (inter)disciplinary, theoretical, methodological, and thematic contributions about challenges and opportunities in **inclusive education in Luxembourg and beyond**. Topics might include increasing accessibility for children with special needs, language barriers in multilingual contexts, or encountering educational inequalities based on individual background characteristics, such as social and migration status. LuxERA aims to stimulate exchange and cooperation within the field of education and related fields, such as multilingualism, lifelong learning, history of education, sociology of education, etc.

Contributions: We invite researchers to contribute to the conference with a **paper presentation of 20 minutes** (plus 10 minutes of discussion) or a **5-minute poster presentation** in a moderated session (plus discussion). The poster presentation gives room to present (preliminary) results, to discuss early stage project ideas and/or to search for project collaborators to stimulate exchange and get feedback. Contributions should have an explicit focus on education in Luxembourg and related fields.

Languages: English is the preferred language, although we would also welcome presentations in German, French, Luxembourgish.

Abstracts The abstract should cover key questions, theoretical issues, methodology, and (preliminary) findings. Please submit your abstract using the **mandatory template forms** (see QR code below or the links for the nonblinded and blinded version).

Participation: Participation will be **20 €** for emerging researchers in LuxERA, **30 €** for regular LuxERA members, and **60 €** for non-members. We encourage all researchers in our community to join the association and benefit from discounted participation at ECER and LuxERA events. To become a member, please fill out the membership form on the website and make sure to transfer your membership fee of **30 €** before conference registration.

Deadline: The deadline for abstract submission is **30 June 2024**. You are informed after the peer review outcome by September 2024. Please submit your abstract to luxeraconf@uni.lu.
