Call for Papers

The **2026 LuxERA Conference** invites **researchers of all career stages** to present their work, exchange ideas and connect in a collegial atmosphere on Campus Belval. The conference welcomes (inter)disciplinary, theoretical, and methodological contributions about current challenges, opportunities, and developments in educational research in Luxembourg.

Topics include, but are not limited to: the rapidly changing educational landscape; the (increasing) role of technology such as AI in education; evolving curriculum; accessibility for children with special needs; language barriers in multilingual contexts; educational inequalities based on individual background characteristics, such as social and migration status; scholastic performance over the years.

Contributions: We welcome contributions in the following formats:

- **Paper Presentation:** 15-minute presentation
- **Poster Pitch:** 3-minute pitch during a moderated session
- **Ignite Talk:** 20 slides delivered in 5 minutes (15 seconds per slide-autoadvance!)
- **Symposium:** Three 15-minute presentations followed by 15 minutes of general discussion

All contributions will be followed by questions from and exchange with the audience. The poster presentation gives room to present (preliminary) results, to discuss early stage project ideas and/or to search for project collaborators to stimulate exchange and get feedback. Ignite talks encourage brief, engaging, and focused presentations of (developing) project/research ideas that stimulate exchange and foster potential collaborations. In a LuxERA first, symposiums will encompass more in-depth presentations and discussions of an overarching theme and collaborations between different universities/departments are encouraged.

All contributions should have an explicit focus on educational research in Luxembourg or clear relevance to the Luxembourgish educational context.

Languages: English is the preferred language of the conference. However, we also welcome presentations in German, French, or Luxembourgish.

- **Abstracts:** The abstract should cover the main research question(s), theoretical embedding, methodology, and (preliminary) findings. Please submit your abstract using the OASYS platform: [OASYS](#). For your submission, have the following information prepared: title, author(s), affiliation(s), contact information, abstract (character limit 2,000), key words, references. For a symposium, provide additional information for the wrapper: title, author(s), affiliations, contact information, abstract (character limit 2,000)
